

Hodgson v. Minnesota (1990)...5/4.

Invalidated a Minnesota law requiring a two parent notification without a procedure for judicial bypass of the notice requirement. However, the Court upheld another provision that required two parent notification but did include a procedure for judicial waiver, as well as a 48 hour waiting period for minors.

Ohio v. Akron Center for Reproductive Health (1990)...6/3.

Upheld an Ohio statute that required a minor to notify one parent or obtain a judicial waiver. The Court rejected the abortion clinic's claim that the judicial procedure was burdensome.

Rust v. Sullivan (1991).

Upheld federal regulations prohibiting personnel at family planning clinics that receive Title X funds from counseling or referring women regarding abortion.
